

# Much Hadham Neighbourhood Plan

Results of consultation event 18 June 2016

*Our parish, our future*

## **VERY STRONG SUPPORT (>75% APPROVAL):**

- Vision and Objectives
- Replicating the present overall mix of house sizes in future development
- Barn School site development, pepperpot development and for limited housebuilding in the hamlets
- Limited building in sustainable locations adjacent to the present village development boundary
- A Community Land Trust development for local people, even if sited on land off limits to other developers
- All of the proposed Design and Building standards (other than references to new materials and design details)
- All of the Environment proposals

Similarly, these opinions were very strongly supported:

- Enough land is already devoted to amenities
- Land should be found for more off-street car parking
- New technology infrastructure is to be embraced
- The Recreation Ground should devote more space to sports facilities for teenagers

Finally, there was very strong opposition to:

- Building in open countryside, on the flood plain or on the Recreation Ground
- Building with new or unfamiliar materials
- Rebuilding or refurbishment of the village hall and/or mission hall

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## **MAJORITY SUPPORT (>50% BUT <75% APPROVAL):**

- Building another Ash Meadow with adequate parking facilities
- Building on the present allotments site (if it were relocated)
- Limited building behind the War Memorial / Moor Place entrance

Similarly, these opinions attracted support:

- We need more parking restrictions on the high street even if that means moving the parking problem elsewhere.....
- ..... parking in the village slows traffic, making the high street safer

Finally, there was majority opposition to:

- Promoting Much Hadham as a tourist/visitor destination
- Using materials and design details that do not currently exist in the village
