FINANCIAL ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2018

In return for paying rent to the Parish Council, HMF has permission for the bridge, on the green at Perry Green, for access to The Hoops. The rent HMF pay under is due every 4 years and the rent increase is 50% of the preceding rent paid. No rent has been received in the current or prior year. Rent was last due on the 28 June 2015, £60, and rent is next due on the 28 June 2019, £90.
