Welcome

We're committed to keeping Hertfordshire moving and connected with an efficient and reliable transport network. It has been a busy month on site for the A120 Bypass team with construction now well underway.

Upwick Green

Work continues on Upwick Green to carry out reconstruction of the road to raise the levels required to stop flooding in the future.

A full closure has been required due to deep excavations. We are on schedule to reopen on Monday 14 October.

Piling Works

Progress has been made with piling works. We've installed 28 piles for the foundations to the Albury Road overbridge. A further 600m of sheet metal piles have also been installed at River Ash and Albury Tributary to create a cut off wall as part of the dam and flood alleviation works.

Project Roadworks

Upwick Green

Upwick Green, from the junction of Albury Road, will remain closed until Monday 14 October. We would like to thank the local community for their patience and understanding while we carry out this work.

Albury Road

As we progress with construction works, bridge beams will be delivered to site along Albury Road. Due to the width of the lorry we kindly ask that local residents keep the road clear to help us as we move the beams into place. A number of 'no waiting cones' will be placed along Albury Road on the mornings of Monday 7 and Monday 14 October to help ensure the delivery runs smoothly.

Albury Road will also be temporarily closed from 8pm Friday 25 October to 6am Monday 28 October to lift the bridge beams into place from Albury Road.
