A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme

We are writing to update you on the construction of the Little Hadham Bypass and upcoming roadworks. We are now in a position to provide dates and times for the roadworks at the locations shown below.



1. Albury Road

Temporary local parking restrictions will need to be introduced along Albury Road to allow us to bring bridge beams to site. We ask all residents to keep Albury Road clear on the morning of **Monday 7 October** and the morning of **Monday 14 October**. 'No Parking' cones will be set out in advance.

It will be necessary to **close Albury Road** (North of Little Hadham) over the weekend from **8pm Friday 25 October to 6am Monday 28 October**. This is to install the bridge beams.

As a contingency, we may also need to **close Albury Road** over the following weekend from **8pm Friday 1 November to 6am Monday 4 November**. We will only do this if we have been unable to complete the work over the previous weekend.

2. A120 Standon Road

It will be necessary to **close the A120 Standon Road** over two weekends as follows:

- **10pm Friday 8 November to 5am Sunday 10 November.**
- **10pm Friday 22 November to 5am Monday 25 November.**

This part of the works is to construct the new Tilekiln Roundabout.

3. A120 Hadham Road

It will be necessary to **close the A120 Hadham Road** over three weekends as follows:

- **10pm Friday 1 November to 5am Monday 4 November.**
- **10pm Friday 15 November to 5am Monday 18 November.**
- **10pm Friday 29 November to 5am Monday 2 December.**

This is part of the works is to construct the new Hadham Park Roundabout.

Diversion plans for both of the road closures explained in (2) and (3) can be found on the scheme webpage. A link is provided below.
