Key activity this month:

1. Sheet piling at River Ash and Albury Tributary continues. This helps to form a barrier which will prevent water from the flood storage areas from filtering through the ground under the dams
2. Piling at Albury overbridge is completed providing a solid foundation for the new structure
3. Kerbs have been laid at Hadham Park roundabout (image above)
4. We're engaging with local schools, from careers in construction to sharing our findings and learnings from site.

Project Roadworks

In the coming weeks we are planning a number of road closures which are required for the installation of bridge beams and the construction of the new Tilekiln and Hadham Park roundabouts. These include:

1. A120 Hadham Road (Hadham Park Roundabout) weekend closures

- 1 November (10pm) to 4 November (5am)
- 15 November (10pm) to 18 November (5am)
- 22 November (10pm) to 25 November (5am)

2. A120 Standon Road (Tilekiln Roundabout)

- 29 November (10pm) to 2 December (5am) - weekend
- 9 December to 13 December – a week of night closures 10pm to 5am each night

3. Albury Road weekend closures

- 8 November (8pm) – 11 November (6am)
- 15 November (8pm) – 18 November (6am) (only required if we can not complete ahead of schedule)
