**A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme**

Further to our letter dated 14 August, we are writing to inform you of some changes to the delivery of the A120 Little Hadham Bypass and Flood Alleviation Scheme.

**Updated Roadworks and Road Closures**

**A120 Hadham Road**

Weekday temporary traffic lights will be ongoing until **Friday 6 November 2020 (8am-6pm)**.

**Full weekend closures** of the road will be required for the construction of the new Hadham Park Roundabout. This will include:

- Resurfacing from the A120 / A1184 / A1250 roundabout
- Completion of the east embankment
- Drainage, gully installation and commissioning of streetlights
- Surfacing of footpaths and shared path
- Fencing, landscaping and installation of road signs


The road will be closed to the east of Hadham Park. The diversion route (shown on the next page) is via A10, A414 and A1184. Local residents will be able to access Little Hadham from the A10 direction.

All dates are subject to weather conditions and the latest Government Covid 19 guidance.

We have been advised that the drainage renewal works planned by Highways England on the M11 between Junction 7 to Junction 8 in November have been postponed.
