

## MUCH HADHAM PARISH COUNCIL – BURIAL CHARGES

Effective from 5<sup>th</sup> April 2022

The burial charges are reviewed and approved periodically by the Burial Authority.

**For the purposes of the burial charges below, a 'resident' is defined as a person who:**

- was born in the parish;
- has resided in the parish for a minimum total of 20 years, consecutively or not; or
- has resided in the parish for the last 5 years.

If a person does not meet any of the above criteria, then the non-resident rates would be applicable.

No dispensations to any of the fees below will be considered.

### **Burial**

Interment into new grave – Resident	£560
Interment into new grave - Non-resident	£5,610
Interment into re-opened grave – Resident	£335
Interment into re-opened – Non-resident	£2,020
Right to erect a new Memorial – Resident	£145
Right to erect a new Memorial – Non-resident	£365
Right to add an inscription to a Memorial – Resident	£70
Right to add an inscription to a Memorial – Non-resident	£70
Cremated remains into an existing grave – Resident	£285
Cremated remains into an existing grave – Non-resident	£1,715

### **Garden of Remembrance**

Garden of Remembrance – Resident:

- interment fee + gravedigger £445
- new memorial tablet + inscription – estimated £546\*

Garden of Remembrance – Non-resident:

- interment fee + gravedigger £1,875
- new memorial tablet + inscription – estimated £546\*

Garden of Remembrance - Re-open – Resident:

- interment fee + gravedigger £290
- additional memorial tablet inscription – estimated £339\*

Garden of Remembrance - Re-open – Non-resident:

- interment fee + gravedigger £945
- additional memorial tablet inscription – estimated £339\*

New memorial tablet price includes 50 letters free. Charges apply for additional letters with maximum constrained by tablet size.

Additional memorial tablet inscription includes removal and replacement of tablet and estimated cost per letter for 50 letters.
