

NOTICE OF MAKING OF A DIVERSION ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

The above Order, made on 29th of August 2024 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert approximately 65 metres of the public footpaths running through Dell Cottage, Kettle Green Lane, Much Hadham, from TL 4224 1860 (Point A) south west to TL 4222 1858 (Point E) and south to TL 4222 1854 (Point F), to a line along the access track for approximately 35 metres from TL 4222 1858 (Point E) north then east to TL 4224 1860 (Point A), then east south-east then south for approximately 65 metres to a junction with Kettle Green Lane (public highway) at TL 4228 1855 (Point B), then continuing south of Kettle Green Lane for approximately 5 metres at TL 4228 1855 (Point C) then west and south-west along the northern field boundary for approximately 70 metres to TL 4222 1852 (Point D) as shown on the Order Plan.
