Following discussion, RESOLVED to approve items of work at Perry Green detailed at points 3 and 4 (stump work and hedge by tarmac carpark). For the remaining items at Perry Green, agreed the following action:

- tree work detailed at point 1 seek 2 additional quotes;
- removal of spoil and detritus material as per point 2 revisit at the March meeting;
   and
- repair of iron fence (point 5) revisit once damage seen by Cllrs.

In respect of the work detailed for St Andrew's burial ground, the Chairman to organise a 'clean up day', seeking help from the scouts/explorers. Provisionally identified Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> April as the date for this. Comparative quotes for the work on the Holly tree to be sought.

#### **Estimate**

As discussed with Fiona at site meeting before Christmas. Proposal and Costings for various works as follows

#### **Perry Green Burial Ground**

1

A) Hornbeam by seat, under phone wires. Reduction by 40% and thinning of crown.

B) Oak, in centre bed.

Reduction and shaping by 20% and thinning of crown.

C) Lime, opposite St Thomas gate.

Clean crown.

D) Malus, Inside gate on left.

Crown lift by removing 4 main lower branches, cleaning crown and reduction by 20% to try and achieve similar appearance as the other two Malus on the right hand side of the gate.

- E) The removal of the dead hawthorn on the hedge line, shaping and lifting of crown on the remaining 5 Hawthorns. the removal of deadwood, leaving ivy. All debris to be removed from site.

- 2) The removal of spoil and detritus material on the left hand side of ground. £395.00+vat
- 3)Stump grinding of 4 stumps in mowing area(not previously carried out correctly by others)

- 4) Clear out hedge and gap up (approximately 12 plants)
  At top of privet hedge by tarmac carpark

5) Repair of iron fence damaged by vehicle. £280.00 +vat

Lift Crown to remove branches encroaching over graves at the base of the tree. Remove Sycamore suckers, elder etc and shape and balance tree by reducing by approximately 20% £540.00+vat
