(ii) Objections raised on the following application:

3/16/0485/HH – First floor extensions with new roof to create additional first floor accommodation, single storey extension to side and double storey extension to front and rear, following demolition of existing side extension and rear conservatory at Whiskers, South End, Perry Green.

Reason:

- The proposed development would represent an over-intensification of the site resulting in it being disproportionate to the size of the original size of the property, which would harm the open aspect of the setting.
- The proposed development would be contrary to policies GBC3 and EN5 of the East Herts Local Plan (2007).

Members also expressed their concern that this type of development reduced the stock of smaller housing.
