#### 18/51. CHAIR'S ANNOUNCEMENTS

The Chair reported that Punch Taverns had been in touch with a revised proposal for The Bull Inn site. This is to be circulated and Punch Taverns to be invited to present on the revised proposal in due course.

# 18/52. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

RESOLVED that the minutes of the last meeting held on 3 April 2018 be accepted as a correct record of the proceedings and be signed by the Chair.

#### 18/53. REPORTS ON OUTSTANDING MATTERS

Report on outstanding matters received. The following points were noted:

<u>The Lodge, New Barns Lane</u> – response from East Herts Council received that if there was a change in circumstance, it would be investigated. It has been made clear to the owner what his obligations and planning permissions are.
